- Congratulation to Wostawea who won a Club Podium Award of Nordig Canada:
 - 3rd Place (Small Category) Highest % increase in pts awarded for the number of licensed skiers in the club (vs previous year ranking)

Marc Leclair has a preliminary calendar prepared with the preferred dates of the clubs for the season 2020-2021. There could be a lot of changes because of Covid-19, we do not know how things will be. Marc will be communicating with the clubs to finalize the preliminary schedule in the fall. A link of the draft calendar can be found at **Appendix B.**

Dave Moore ask if the Wostawea's Sprint would be a sanctioned NB Cup. John Ball (President Wostawea) said they would like to have it as a sanctioned event if the CCNB Board agreed.

Concern was voiced for the number of races in relations to the Long-Term Development of Athletes. It was pointed out that some of these races could be approached as training races, not to push the race. It is also important to have as many races as possible for the athletes that are not at the elite level, give them more opportunities to participate while staying in the province to do so. The High-Performance Committee will also have to review the number of races the NB Team will need to participate at, within the province.

Covid-19

- It will certainly be affecting the races. We may not be able to have mass starts, many other things will need to be looked at.
- Jean-Luc Benoit(Prov NB representative) added that the return to normal will not happen until there is a vaccine. Current restrictions will probably stay until we have that vaccine.
- It was also pointed out that the social side of the events will be difficult to have (lunches, medal presentations, ...)
- Raymond informed there is an Operational Plan started for CCNB. We will need to follow Nordiq Canada and NB Public Heath recommendations, policies and restrictions. We will have something ready for the fall to discuss and put in place for the next season. The Operational Plan will cover events, teaching lessons and regular club activities.
- Jean-Luc Benoit also pointed out that clubs will need to coordinate with municipalities, owner/operators of facilities to make sure everything is respected in all operational plans.
- It was suggested that we may want to transition with older athletes starting first and have them be mentors/models for the younger athletes when we return to sport.

Youth Program and Recreational – Claudette Kavanaugh

- On page 8 of the PowerPoint presentation there is a table showing the numbers of participants in the Jackrabbit program per clubs for the last 3 years. The link for the PowerPoint presentation is at **Appendix C.**
- Some clubs are hitting there max for their Jackrabbit program because not enough coaches, not enough equipment or a combination. It was suggested that clubs that are seeing increases if they could share their successes with other clubs.

High Performance:

- The Nationals was cancelled because of Covid-19.
- Easterns were in Sherbrooke, Quebec. We had 11 athletes participate.
- We had 11 athletes participate at Joliette. The unofficial NB Team won 1st place for the Relay. There were some Top 10 finishes.
- Jeremy Leigh had some Top 10 results (personal best).
- Anika Leigh also had some personal best results this season.
- High Performance Committee had planned a workday in April but had to cancel because of Covid-19. They hope to have one in Fall. Many documents need to be reviewed.
