# High Performance Programs



- Coordinates national race calendar
- Funds and operates the National Ski Team (Senior, Under-23, Junior and Para-nordic), including selection, equipping, coaching, training and competitions
- Partially funds National Team Development Centers
- Trains high level official and coaches





# Support for members and clubs

- Raises funds for Association functions and programs
- Develops and maintains the Long Term Athlete Development Model
- Develops coach training programs and documentation, and supervises higher level certification
- Develops programs and designs, produces and supplies materials for the Skill Development Program for youth skiers, as well as Leader Training courses
- Runs course conductor training courses and upgrades (train the trainers)
